MAKING THE TEMPLATES

You can make a sturdy, reusable template for cutting out biscuit shapes from plastic. The lids of margarine or ice cream tubs are ideal. Stick our template outline to your clean plastic lid and cut around with scissors, or use a craft knife and cutting mat if you have them.

USING THE TEMPLATES

Place the template on your biscuit dough and use the tip of a knife to cut around the template. When you have gone all the way round, slip the knife underneath to help lift it from the dough. Place your cut biscuits on lined baking sheets as you go. Keep cutting shapes until the dough is used up - you can re-roll the trimmings once which will give you a few extra. If you have a marble slab, roll your biscuit dough out on that, as it will help to keep the dough cool.
